Friday April 8th May 9th
begins fair weather, wind light and calm, as
before stated for Thursday Lat 29. 46
Long 50. 33

Saturday May 10th
begins strong S.W. wind
steering by W. at night close reefed & middle
wind veered to S.W. later moderate wind, now
saw one sail to end Lat 30. 29

Sunday May 11th
begins fair steering by to the
N.E. all sail at night 2 reef 1/2, wind at middle
and latter calm saw ship back, ready Lat 31. 59
Long 49. 58

Monday May 12th
begins calm first part
remains calm to end Lat 31. 10

Tuesday May 13th
this day calm saw 1/2 one sail to end
Lat 31. 55
Long 49. 35

New Bedford North Atlantic 255
Wednesday May 14th
begins light air from E. to N.E., middle
and latter fresh breeze from South by East Lat 31. 00

Thursday May 15th
begins more moderate S.W. than
finback previous wind at night close reefed 1/2 left to 5th
middle and latter a gale from South to end

Friday May 16th begins a gale from S middle
wind from W blowing strong and rough
at 8 wore ship to S.W. to end Lat 33. 42 W
Long 47. 18 W

Saturday May 17th
begins strong S.W. wind and rough
sea lying to under close reef 1/2, at night
under close reef 1/2, heading at 1/2 middle &
latter less wind heavy swell so in Lat 34. 6 Long 46. 4 W
Sunday 18th heavy squall moderate wind short sail
steering by N.E. (from water) middle &
left air N.E. 9 at 9 saw S.W. Lat 32. 56
10 covered North to end Long 46. 04
