Monday May 19th

begins light NE wind, backing at
two get the whole to ship (at last draw) in
in the whole and cut up at night hoisted for
more but going too quick about 11 or 12 by 3 and
all were large (mostly school whale) middle and
latter calm light S wind so ends Lat 34.26 or
at 10 AM started for

Tuesday May 20th

begins pleasant employed sailing at
8 finished cloudy moderate wind from South
middle and latter light S wind steering
by 10 S to end

Lat 34.18
Long 45.13

Wednesday May 21st

begins moderate cloudy steady
until 9 S S. then some falling part of a break
deck plank has one bit steering S S. middle and latter
fair steady saw finbacks so ends Lat 35.16 or
Long 46.47 W

of S. B. North Atlantic 255
Thursday May 22nd

begins fair steering by NW all sail
saw finbacks night shortened sail heading N. middle
and latter strong wind at 8 bore ship to the S S. Lat 35.00
Long 46.16

Friday May 23rd

begins strong S S. wind steering by
S saw finbacks at night close up middle and latter
strong wind some rain by wind from S S. Lat 34.60
Saw Jack him Big steering Eastward Long 46.50

Saturday May 24th

begins more moderate steering by W. ends
about 11 S at night 2 up middle and latter the same
with a heavy swell from NW causing Lat 33.32
Long 45.54

Sunday May 25th

begins moderate wind W. W.
steering to S saw finback middle and latter light
air heavy saw S S. so ends Lat 32.30 or
Long 46.35
