at sunset had the whole to the ship with
N. wind, middle and later calm at daylight comm-
enced cutting at 10 had the whole to the end Lat 35.05

Sunday June 8th

begins pleasant at one started fire on board
at night light air from N.E. saw greenish perforce
& heading N.E. at sunset had of on Friday &
saw perforce light air calm Lat 34.60
Long 48.28

Monday June 9th

begins light steady air & heading N.E. & heading N.E.
at 9 P.M. finished & saw greenish plenty perforce
& middle and later calm put on down &
so ends foreback
