papers a bit sail at 11 Lat 34. 00 N  
Long 46. 43 W

Friday July 18<sup>th</sup>

blowing strong from NW to 24 N  
at 9 PM here to 18<sup>th</sup> under 18<sup>th</sup> 18<sup>th</sup>  
as only Lat 35. 68  
Long 46. 00

Saturday July 19<sup>th</sup>

begins moderate breeze at 5 AM  
light off 6 about sail at 8<sup>th</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> from
