Tuesday July 22nd
begins and ends pleasant
steering by the wind N E by W 1 sail in
sight saw plenty per - Old Fish
Lat 37. 10 N
Long 37. 38 W

North Atlantic

Wednesday July 23rd
begins and ends fair sailing
steering N E by E two sail in sight one a ship other
a brig heading E. N. Lat 37. 46
Long 35. 39 W

Thursday July 24th
light breeze from N E to W
at 1 PM picked up a large mast
off from a steamer being 50 ft long
26 inches diameter having one hand with
6 eyes for - (further down) Lat 38. 00
many over board. Long 34. 40 W

Friday July 25th
finishing begins pleasant
steering by the wind N E by W the 1st ship in sight
at night spoke Europa steering W. Lat 38. 00
Long 34. 40 W
