

Remarks on Board the bark Laetitia

Sunday Sept 13th 1854

Commences with light airs and calms middle and latter part light winds from the Westward and pleasant ship heading S by E Lat 31.02 N Long 20.32 W

Monday 14th

Commences with light breezes from the W by N and squally ship heading S by E middle part the same latter part light winds from the S E and pleasant ship heading S by W Lat 30.29 N Long 20.50 W

Tuesday 15th

Commences with light breezes from the S by E and pleasant ship heading S by W towards up the starboard boat and pointed saw grampers middle and latter part light airs and calms Lat 29.59 N Long 20.17 W

Wednesday ~~Friday~~ 16th

Coms in with light airs from the S E and pleasant ships course S by E employed at taining ship out side three sails in sight middle and latter part the same Lat 29.12 N Long 20.20 W

Thursday 17th

Commences with light winds from the Northward and pleasant ships course S by W five ships in sight steering S W middle and latter part calm thus ends Lat 28.57 N Long 20.19 W

Outward Bound

Friday 18th 1854

Commences with light airs and calms five sails in sight middle and latter part light winds from the S E thus ends Lat 28.19 N Long 20.33 W

Saturday 19th

Commences with fine breezes from the S by E and pleasant ships course S by W four ships in sight middle and latter part strong trade employed at stowing down oil Lat 25.52 N Long 21.26 W

Sunday 20th

Coms in with strong trade and pleasant ships course S by W one three masted ship in sight middle and latter part the same thus ends Lat 23.04 N Long 22.47 W

Monday 21st

Commences with strong trade and mooney weather ships course S by W in sight middle and latter part weather the same Lat 20.39 N Long 24.08 W

Tuesday 22nd

Commences with strong trade and cloudy ships course S by W middle and latter part the same thus ends Lat 19.79 N Long 25.23 W

Wednesday 23rd

Coms in with moderate trade and cloudy ships course S by W middle part laying aback day light mail the land steered S by W Lat 16.55 N Long 25.36 W
