

Remarks on Board the Bark Lactitia

Saturday October 24th 1857

Commences with strong breezes S.E. and pleasant ship heading S.W. Under topsails main topgallant sent a new fore topmast staysail one ship in sight heading S.W. middle and latter part fine weather

Sunday 25th

Commences with strong breezes from Eastward at bad sea from the Southward saw humpbacks speak the bark Halken Marble two months out clear middle and latter part pleasant ship course S.W.

Monday 26th

Commences with fine breezes from the S.E. and pleasant ship course S.W. saw a few humpbacks middle and latter part strong breezes from the Northward ship course S.W. by W

Lat 24.09 N

Long 36.17 W

Tuesday 27th

Commences with strong breezes from the North ship course S.W. by W sent a new main topmast middle and latter part the same

Lat 26.01

Long 37.52 W

Wednesday 28th

Come in with strong breezes from the N.E. and smoky weather ship course S.W. saw sails heading to the Eastward at sea down left to the wind under double reefed topsails heading S.W. middle and latter part weather the same

Lat 26.24

Long 38.07

Thursday 29th Oct

Commences with light winds from the Southward and smoky weather a bad sea on ship heading S.W. middle part wind shifted to the Southward with rain latter part moderate gals ship under close reefed main topmast fore topmast staysail and main spencer Observation

Friday 30th

Commences with moderate gals from the Southward ship heading S.W. by W saw a number of humpbacks middle and latter part moderate and rugged

Saturday 31st

Come in with strong winds from the S.E. and pleasant steering S.W. saw a brig steering S.E. at sunset shotred sail left to the wind middle and latter part weather the same

Lat 28.44 N

Long 42.31 W

Sunday November 1st

Commences with strong winds from the S.E. and pleasant steering S.W. at sunset left to the wind heading S.E. by S middle part steering S.W.

Lat 29.03 N

Long 43.50 W

Monday 2nd

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E. and cloudy weather ship course S.W. middle and latter part the same
