

Remarks on Board the Bark Laetitia

Thursday November 19th 1857

Commences with strong winds from the S. toward ships course SSW at 5 P.M. shortened sail and left to heading N by N middle part the same latter part fresh winds from the S. ship heading SSW

Friday 20th

Commences with fresh breezes from the S E and ragged ship heading SSW under close reefed main topsail and fore sail latter part pleasant steering SSW saw humpbacks several

Saturday 21st

Commences with moderate breezes from the S E and pleasant ship's course SSW saw finbacks one sail in sight at sundown shortened sail and left to wind heading SSW latter part steering SSW

Sunday 22nd

Commences with light winds from S S E and cloudy weather steering SSW speak the bark Mary Ann of Mattaponec fourteen months out three hundred spinn oil one hundred whale middle and latter part weather the same steering South

Commences with light winds from SSW and cloudy weather ship's course South saw several finbacks middle and latter part strong breezes from the WSW speak the bark Washington of Sag Harbor

Thursday 24th

Commences with strong winds from the SSW and ragged ship heading South saw a number of finbacks latter part fresh breezes from the WSW

Wednesday 25th

Commences with gals from the SSW and ragged ship under close reefed main topsail and storm sails heading S E middle part the same latter part moderate winds from the WSW

Thursday 26th

Commences with fresh breezes from the WSW and ragged ship heading SSW saw a plenty of finbacks middle and latter part gals from the SSW

Friday 27th

Comes in with gals from the SSW ship heading WSW under close reefed topsails, main spinn and fore topmast staysail middle and latter part weather the same in Ob

Saturday 28th

Commences with fresh gals from the SSW and cloudy weather ship heading SSW middle part the latter part strong breezes

Comes in with fresh gals from the Westward middle and latter part moderate
