

Remarks on Board the Bark Lachia

Saturday January 9th 1858
Commences with light breezes from W & W and
cloudy weather ship heading S & W middle and
latter part strong winds from the Westward
Lat 46.36 N
Long 81.19 W

Sunday 10th
Commences with strong winds from the West
and cloudy weather ship heading S & W
middle part foggy latter part pleasant sun
sails heading to the Southward Lat 44.18 N
Long 80.31 W

Monday 11th
Commences with fine wind from the Westward
and pleasant ship heading S & W middle and
latter part the same thus ends Lat 41.39 N
Long 80.40 W

Tuesday 12th
Commences with light winds from the Westward
and pleasant ship heading S & W by S middle
and latter part wind from the S & W at 4 A.M.
saw a school of sperm whales lured the
boats lost sight of the whales Lat 39.15 N
Long 81.12 W

Wednesday 13th
Commences with light winds from the South
and pleasant ^{at ship} steering E & E middle and
latter part the same Lat 37.53 N
Long 82.13 W

On a Whale Voyage

Thursday 14th
Commences with light winds from the South
and pleasant at 3 P.M. raised whale level
the boats had one mixed middle part light
winds latter part calm saw killers and grampuses
Lat 37.41 N
Long 82.30 W

Friday 15th
Commences with light winds from the West
and pleasant steering E & at sunset shortened
sail and left to the wind latter part strong
breezes from the W & W Lat 37.45 N
Long 81.26 W

Saturday 16th
Commences with strong breezes from the
W & W and cloudy weather saw blackfish
and Porpoise latter part light winds from
the Southward saw blackfish Lat 36.45 N
Long 81.33 W

Sunday 17th
Commences with light winds from the S & E
and cloudy weather middle and latter part
the same Lat 36.05 N
Long 83.41 W

Monday 18th
Commences with light winds from the S & E
and pleasant saw two finbacks and several
pieces of squid middle and latter part the
same saw a sail heading to the Southward
Lat 35.08 N
Long 83.52 W
