

Remarks on Board the Bark Larkia

Monday February 8th 1858
Commences with strong breezes from Westward and pleasant at 6 P.M. the South end island Juan Fernandez bearing E by S ten miles latter part strong wind from the S E at 11 A.M. rose sperm whals at meridian level three boats the South end of the island bearing South dist 8 miles so ends

Tuesday 9th
Commences with strong breezes from the S E boats off in pursuit of whale struck and killed two took the to the ship and commence cutting latter part weather the same employed at cutting

Wednesday 10th
Commences with strong breezes from the S E employed cutting at 6 P.M. finished one whal and commenced loading latter part to suggest boat employed and cutting blubber

Thursday 11th
Commences with strong breezes from the S E and a bad sea employed at loading middle part the same latter part employed at cutting so ends

Friday 12th
Commences with strong breezes from the S E and rigged employed at cutting finished at 5 P.M. middle and latter part loading

Causing for Sperm Whals

Saturday Feb 13th 1858
Commences with strong breezes from the S E and rigged ship heading S E employed at loading middle and latter part the same

Lat 32.46 S
Long 80.30 W

Sunday 14th
Commences with light winds from the S E and pleasant ship heading S E employed at loading oil middle and latter part weather the same thus ends

Lat 32.56 S
Long 80.45 W

Monday 15th
Commences with light breezes from the S E and pleasant ships course E middle part the same latter part strong breezes employed at slowing down oil

Lat 33.11 S
Long 79.40 W

Tuesday 16th
Commences with fresh breezes from the Westward and rainy at 3 P.M. wind shifted in a squall to the S E middle and latter part strong breezes and rigged the island of Juan Fernandez bearing E S E dist 40 miles

Wednesday 17th
Commences with strong breezes from the S E and rigged employed at slowing down oil middle and latter part weather the same
