Thursday February 18th 1858
Commences with strong winds from the S E
and cloudy weather middle and latter part
light winds

Friday 19th
Coms in with light breezes from the S E
mid pleasant middle part the same latter
part strong breezes from the W S W at 11 A M
went in a fishing at the island from Fernandez

Saturday 20th
Commences with strong winds from the W S W
two boats in a fishing com in board at
3 P.M. two sails in sight middle and latter
part fresh breezes saw two ships steering
S

Sunday 21st
Coms in with gale from the Westward
ship heading S by W saw a school of
blackfish middle and latter part weather
the same

Monday 22nd
Coms in with fresh gale from the W S W
ship heading South middle and latter part
the same

Long 77.27 W

Lactitia on a Whale Voyage

Tuesday February 23rd 1858
Coms in with fresh breezes from the Southward
and squally steering S at sunset left to the
wind heading W under close reefed topsails
middle and latter part moderate thus ends

Lat 35.01 S
Long 76.04 W

Wednesday 24th
Commences with strong breezes from the W S W
and pleasant ship heading S middle and latter
part light winds

Lat 32.49 S
Long 76.30 W

Thursday 25th
Commences with light breezes from the
S W and pleasant ship course S S W saw
Porpoise and grampers middle and latter
part the same

Lat 32.07 S
Long 76.31 W

Friday 26th
Commences with light winds from the S S W
and pleasant ship course S saw finbacks
grampers and porpoise middle and latter
part light airs and calms

Lat 30.58 S
Long 76.26 W

Saturday 27th
Commences with light winds from the
S W and pleasant latter part light
winds from the W S W ship heading S E

Long 75.54 W
