the S E and thick weather ship course S E by W.
saw a brig heading to the Eastward

the same

S W latter part S by W

Monday 8th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
steering S by W two sails in sight middle
and latter part weather the same

Commences with light trade and pleasant
loved the boats for blackfish took for
middle and latter part weather the same
