set nine ship heading N.E. S latter part

Commences with light trade and passing
rain signals middle and latter part pleasant
Lat 16.16 S
Long 75.58 W

Sunday 14th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
saw finback many porpoise latter part
strong breeze saw a grate many black
fish loved the boats took three
as observation

Wednesday 17th
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
saw blackfish one sail middle and latter
part light trade Lat 17.14 S
Long 77.31 W

Thursday 18th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
saw one finback middle and latter part
weather the same saw a brig heading N.W.
Lat 16.44 S
Long 77.51 W

Friday 19th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
saw blackfish loved the boats took four
middle and latter squally Lat 16.03 S
Long 77.35 W

Saturday 20th
Commences with light variable winds and
cloudy weather middle and latter part strong
trade saw a bark heading N.W.
Lat 15.24 S
Long 78.46 W
