saw many finbacks and porpoise and
blackfish middle and latter part strong trade
their ends

no success latter part saw a great many
blackfish land two boats had no success

ships course S by W latter part strong trade
steered S by W

Friday March 26th 1856

Commences with light trade and pleasant ships
course S by W middle and latter part the same

Saturday 27th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ships course S by W a big in sight to
the Eastward middle part the same latter
part moderate land the boats for blackfish
took three Point Aguia in sight leaving
E S E dist 25 miles

Long 81.28 W

Sunday 28th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ships course S by S at 6 P. M. Pasta head
bearing S S E dist 25 miles left to the wind
with main yard aback heading W middle and
latter part calm

Lat 4.16 N

Long 81.11 W

Monday 29th

Commences with light winds and pleasant
heading in for Pasta head middle part
loosening off and on latter part steady in
at 1 A. M. Anchored at Pasta

April 4th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
at 1 P. M. took the Anchor got under started
W by S saw finbacks several one shoal
of blackfish middle part the same latter part
calm
