

Remarks on Board the

Monday April 5th 1858

Commences with light trade and pleasant steering at sunset land in sight middle part laying aback latter part calm land in sight

Tuesday 6th

Commences with fine breeze from the W & W steering S by E at sunset land bearing S & E dist 15 miles and calm middle part calm latter part light airs from the W & W

Wednesday 7th

Commences with light winds from the W & W and pleasant at 4 P.M. anchored off Tombig in three fathoms water

Thursday April 11th

Latter part light airs from the Eastward and pleasant at 6 A.M. took the anchor and under way thus ends

Monday 12th

Commences with light winds from the Westward working out the gulf saw a number of back sound in the Tombig middle and latter part light air from the S & W ship heading W saw finbacks and Blackfish Lat 3.15 S Long 81.15 W

Tuesday 13th

Came in with light winds from the Southward ship heading W by S middle and latter part heading S by E Lat 3.33 S Long 82.25

Bark Sactico

Wednesday April 14th 1858

Commences with light winds from the S & E and pleasant ship heading W by S saw Black fish and many flying fish middle and latter part wind from the Southward ship heading W by S

Long 84.37 W

Thursday 15th

Commences with light winds from the S & E and pleasant ship's course W by S saw finbacks and Blackfish middle and latter part fine trade

Lat 5.55 N

Long 86.12 W

Friday 16th

Commences with fine trade and cloudy ship's course S by W saw humpbacks middle and latter part weather the same

Lat 6.32 N

Long 88.33 W

Saturday 17th

Commences with fine trade and pleasant ship's course W by S saw a number finbacks middle and latter part weather the same

Lat 6.30 N

Long 91.14 W

Sunday 18th

Commences with fine trade and pleasant ship's course W by S saw several sharks Blackfish saw a stage loved a boat went to it bought a Dolphin middle and latter part strong trade
