heading S.W. middle part the same latter
part steering S.W.

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ships course S.W. saw two Shoals Blackfish
at sunset shortened sail steered S.W. by W
middle part the same latter part steering
W

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
ships course W at sunset left to the wind
heading S.W. middle part the same
latter part steering S.W.

ships course S.W. saw Blackfish fin Backs
at sunset shortened sail steered S.W. middle
part the same latter part steering S.W.

Saturday April 24th 1853

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ships course S.W. at sunset shortened
sail left to the wind heading S.E. middle
part the same latter heading S.W. saw
several fin Backs

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ships heading S.W. middle the same latter
ships course S.E. Lat 5.27 S

Long 102.07 W

Monday 26th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
saw fin Backs middle and latter part the
same thus ends

Tuesday 27th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
saw fin Backs speak the ship Hector
eighteen months out with seven hundred
lbs sperm middle part rainy latter part
pleasant

saw a ship steering S.W. middle part
