Thursday April 29th 1858
Commences with strong trade and rugged
sun-finchbacks grampases and porpoise middle
and latter part the same Lat 3.39 S
Long 103.37 W

Friday 30th
Commences with strong trade and rugged
sun on finbacks and Porpoise middle and
latter part weather the same Lat 4.06 S
Long 104.08 W

Saturday May 1st
Coms in with strong trade and pleasant
sun finbacks one ship reported the
Ansel Gils heading to the S.E. middle
and latter part moderate Lat 5.10 S
Long 106.12 W

Sunday 2nd
Coms in with moderate trade and pleasant
sun finbacks middle and latter part
weather the same Lat 4.55 S
Long 107.09 W

Monday 3rd
Commences with strong trade and reports
of rain sun a sail to the Westward
middle and latter part strong trade at
8 A.M. saw a sperm whale lured the
boats had no success Lat 4.21 S
Long 107.21 W

Tuesday 4th
Coms in with strong trade speak the
ship Ansel Gils 40 months old with 1600
middle and latter part moderate at 8 A.M.
saw a shoal of whales lured the boats streak
and killed three took them to the ship
Lat 4.50 S
Long 107.50

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
employed at cutting sun a ship to the S.W.
middle part cutting the latter part
employed at cutting finished at 10 A.M.
shorted the nets Lat 3.57 S
Long 108.20 W

Thursday 6th
Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
employed at boiling sun the ship Hector
past to the Westward of our middle part
strong trade ship heading S by W latter
part weather the same at 6 A.M. saw
a shoal of whales lured the boats at
8 stroke and kill one took him to the
ship Lat 4.58 S
Long 108.40 W

Friday 7th
Commences with strong trade and rugged
employed at cutting took the today left
the head a long side at 5 P.M. Commence
boiling middle and latter part weather
the same took in the head wire ship to
the S.E. Lat 4.42 S
Long 109.45 W

Saturday 8th
Commences with strong trade employed
at boiling middle and latter part the same
Lat 4.09 S
Long 109.27 W
