Sunday May 9th 1858
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
employed at boiling saw a ship to the
windward at 6 P.M. Cook down the north
middle and latter part weather the same
employed at scalding the case Lat 5.49 S
Long 108.39 W

Monday 10th
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
middle and latter part weather the same
employed at stowing down Lat 4.06 S

Tuesday 11th
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
employed at stowing down middle and latter
part weather the same Lat 4.46 S
Long 100.00 W

Wednesday 12th
Commences with strong trade and squally
employed at stowing down middle and latter
part weather the same Lat 5.23 S
Long 110.14 W

Thursday 13th
Commences with strong trade and rugged
ship heading 188 S middle and latter part
squally some rain Lat 4.56 S
Long 110.00 W

Friday 14th
Commences with strong trade and rugged
middle and latter part weather the same
sun in forenoon Lat 4.35 S
Long 109.09 W

Bark Lactitia

Saturday May 16th 1858
Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
at 4 P.M. rose whals to the windward at
5 level the boats had no success a ship
to the windward whaling middle and latter
part weather the same at 10 A.M. rose a low
level the boats had no success Lat 4.30 S
Long 108.55 W

Sunday 17th
Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
at 4 P.M. rose a shoal of whals at half past
five level the boats had no success middle
and latter part weather the same a Bark
in sight to the Westward boiling
Lat 4.21 S
Long 109.20 W

Monday 18th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
at 2 P.M. rose a shoal of whals at 3
level the boats struck and killed one
had one boat stove took the whale to
the ship at 5 P.M. and commenced cutting
two sails in sight one whaling middle
and latter part fine weather employed
at boiling cutting finished at 10 A.M. and started
the works Lat 3.57 S
Long 109.03 W

Tuesday 19th
Commences with pleasant weather employed at
boiling spoke the Bark Emily seven months
out with 150 bbls sperm middle and latter part
weather the same Lat 4.37 S
Long 109.37 W
