latter part strong trade at 7 A.M. saw spin
whals off the weather bar going to the windward
quick did not meet the boats Lat 4.35 S

Thursday 21st

Commences with strong trade and rigged
employed at stowing water in the after hold
middle and latter part weather the same employed
at stowing oil Lat 4.20 S
Long 108.54 W

Friday 22nd

Commences with strong trade and squally
employed at stowing down middle and latter
part weather the same took in the last of
boat to repair Lat 4.12 S
Long 108.44 W

Saturday 23rd

Commences with fresh trade and rigged
employed at mending a boat latter part
the same Lat 4.04 S
Long 108.51 W

Sunday 24th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
we sail in sight middle and latter
part weather the same Lat 5.05 S
Long 109.05 W

Monday 25th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
saw bark Emaly in sight middle and latter
part moderate Lat 4.47 S
Long 108.45

Thursday 27th

Commences with strong trade and squally
middle and latter part moderate Lat 3.53 S
Long 108.11 W

Friday 28th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
saw several finbacks and many porpoises
middle and latter part weather the same Lat 4.25 S
Long 110.12 W

Saturday 29th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ships course W.S.W. saw a bark heading
S.W. at 6 P.M. left to the wind heading S.W.
latter part strong S.W. Lat 4.04 S
Long 111.14 W

Sunday 30th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
steering S.W. at 6 P.M. left to heading S.W.
latter part steering S Lat 4.11 S
Long 112.00 W
