wind on the S.E. tack middle part the same
latter part steering S.W. Lat 4.25 S
Long 112.31 W

Tuesday June 1st
Commences with strong trade and veered
middle and latter part the same that ends
Lat 4.33 S
Long 112.53 W

Wednesday 2nd
Commences with strong trade on bent
the fore sail and repaired it middle and
latter part weather the same Lat 4.41 S
Long 113.01 W

Thursday 3rd
Commences with strong trade and veered
saw one finback middle and latter part
strong breezes from the Eastward passing
squalls of rain Lat 5.44 S
Long 110.15 W

Friday 4th
Commences with strong breezes from the
Eastward middle and latter part the same
Lat 4.44 S
Long 112.47 W

Saturday 5th
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
middle and latter part the same
Lat 5.32 S
Long 111.53 W

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
middle and latter part the same
Lat 2.29 S
Long 110.45 W

Monday 7th
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
saw several finbacks and Porpoise middle
and latter part weather the same ship
heading S by E Lat 4.11 S
Long 111.06 W

Tuesday 8th
Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
ship heading S at 6 P.M. tack ship to the
S.E. middle part the same latter part
heading S by W Lat 4.25 S
Long 111.05 W

Wednesday 9th
Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
ship heading S.E. middle and latter part
strong breezes and squally saw two sails
heading to the Southward Lat 3.49 S
Long 110.06 W

Thursday 10th
Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ship heading S by W at 6 P.M. tack to the
S.E. one sail in sight to the Eastward
middle and latter part weather the same
saw one finback Lat 4.23 S
Long 110.26 W
