Tuesday July 13th 1858

Commences with moderate trade and squally
ship heading E & S middle and latter part
strong trade heading E by S Lat 9.06 S
Long 17.08 W

Wednesday 14th

Commences with strong trade and cloudy
weather ship heading E by S middle and
latter part weather the same Lat 2.21 S
Long 14.59 W

Thursday 15th

Commences with strong trade and cloudy
weather ship heading E by S saw one fin back
blackfish sea-fish grampse and many
birds middle and latter part moderate trade
with passing fog squalls Lat 2.06 S
Long 12.52 W

Friday 16th

Commences with moderate trade thick
cloudy weather ship heading E by S
middle and latter part weather the same
saw blackfish at 10 A.M. raised the
Culpeppers island bearing E by S 100
compass Lat 1.47 S
Long by C.D. 11.44

Saturday 17th

Commences with moderate trade and
cloudy weather steering for the island
at 5 P.M. went in a fishing caught
one middle and latter part weather the
same at 10 A.M. went in to the island a
fishing got on board past Meridare

Bark Lactitia

Sunday July 18th 1858

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
steering by the wind heading E by S at 6 P.M.
saw Breaches to the lee and the Culpeppers
island bearing S by W dist 20 miles middle
and latter part squally Lat 2.00 S
Long 11.44 W

Monday 19th

Commences with light winds and passing
fog squalls ship heading E & S saw
humpbacks middle and latter part weather
the same Lat 2.16 S
Long 10.14 W

Tuesday 20th

Commences with strong trade and squally
ship heading E by S saw several fin back
middle and latter part weather the same
Lat 2.35 S
Long 8.07 W

Wednesday 21st

Commences with moderate trade and cloudy
weather ship heading E middle and latter
part weather the same ship heading E & S
no observation

Thursday 22nd

Commences with strong trade and cloudy
weather ship heading E & S saw fin backs
Blackfish and Porpoise middle and latter
part weather the same Lat 1.19 S
Long 8.48 W
