Wednesday October 6th 1858

ship heading E by S at 6 P.M. the island
is a long bearing E dist 35 miles middle
and latter part in rather the same employed
at stowing oil at 10 A.M. Boats heading
E by S dist five miles

Thursday 7th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ship heading S.W. by W employed at stowing
down in sail in sight middle and latter
part weather the same two sails in sight

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ship heading S.W. by S saw many finbacks
middle part calm latter part strong trade
with passing fog signals
