Commences with light trades and pleasant ship heading E S E at 6 P.M. the island San Lorenzo bearing E dist 30 miles middle and latter part light airs and calms.

Commences with light breezes and pleasant saw one finback and Blackfish middle and latter part strong trades ships course W

Wednesday 13th

Commences with strong trades and pleasant ships course W S W middle and latter part thick haze weather saw several finbacks

Lat 00.24 S

Long 96.12 W

Thursday 14th

Commences with moderate trades and pleasant ships course W S W at 4 P.M. left to the wind heading W S W middle and latter part calm

Friday 15th

Commences with light trades and pleasant ships course W S W saw Blackfish middle and latter part weather the same steering S W by E

Saturday Oct 16th 1858

Commences with light trades and pleasant ships course S W S saw several finbacks middle part the same latter part steering

Sunday 17th

Commences with strong trades and pleasant saw many finbacks middle and latter part weather the same steering S W

Lat 4.20 N

Long 101.44 S

Monday 18th

Commences with strong trades and pleasant ships course W S W at 6 P.M. left to the wind middle part the same latter part steering S W saw many finbacks

Lat 4.41 N

Long 100.04

Tuesday 19th

Commences with strong trades and pleasant ships course S W at 6 P.M. left to the wind latter part steering S W

Lat 4.42 N

Long 104.07 W

Wednesday 20th

Commences with strong trades and pleasant ships course S W at 6 P.M. left to the wind saw many finbacks latter part steering S W

Thursday 21st

Commences with strong trades and cloudy weather saw many finbacks ships course W S W middle and latter part the same
