Tuesday September 2nd 1848

Commences with strong trade and pleasant weather ships course S. saw finbacks at 6 P.M. left to the wind heading S. E. by E. latter part steering N. W. Sall 4.25 H Long 109.37 W

Wednesday 3rd

Come in with strong trade and rugged ship heading N. W. saw finbacks latter part steering N. W. Sall 4.50 H Long 109.18 W

Thursday 4th

Commences with strong trade and rugged ship heading S. E. latter part heading N. saw Porpoise Sall 4.50 H Long 109.19 W

Friday 5th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant ship heading N. latter part weather the same at 6 A.M. rose a sperm whale going to the windward quick lored the boat and no success Sall 5.27 H Long 109.12 W

Saturday 6th

Come in with strong trade and rugged ship heading S. E. by E. middle part the same latter part heading S Sall 5.22 H Long 109.23 W

Sunday 7th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant ship heading S. W. at 6 P.M. left to the wind heading S. E. middle and latter part moderate saw Blackfish Sall 4.22 H Long 108.42 W

## Bark Lactitia

Monday September 8th 1848

Commences with light trade and pleasant saw finbacks and porpoises ship heading S. E. latter part steering N. saw many finbacks Sall 4.18 H Long 109.16 W

Tuesday 9th

Commences with light trade and pleasant ships course S. W. middle and latter part steering N. Sall 4.32 H Long 111.14 W

Wednesday 10th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant ships course N. W. at 6 P.M. left to the wind heading N. E. by N. middle sailing aback latter part steering N. S. W. Sall 4.50 H Long 112.10 W

Thursday 11th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant speak the Bark Havemede middle and latter part weather the same Sall 5.17 H Long 112.00 W

Friday 12th

Commences with light trade and pleasant middle and latter part strong trade Sall 4.11 H Long 113.16 W

Saturday 13th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant saw a sail to the Eastward middle and latter part squally Sall 4.35 H Long 113.39 W
