Monday 29th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
saw one finback middle and latter part weather
the same Lat 2.53 N
Long 109.21 W

Tuesday 30th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
saw several finbacks middle and latter
part strong trade Lat 2.09 N
Long 107.55 W

Wednesday Dec 1st
Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
saw many finbacks middle part squally
Lat 00.53 N
