Commences with light trades and pleasant
ships course H & W middle and latter part weather
the same had a strong current setting S by E
this last twenty four hours Lat 06.35 S
Long 116.19 W

Friday 31st
Commences with light trades and pleasant
ship heading S tried the current found it
setting W & W the mild per boxer ran fin back
and Perceps middle and latter part weather
the same Lat 15.0 S
Long 116.21 W

Saturday January 1st 1859
Commences with light trades and pleasant
ship heading S ran Perceps middle and
latter part weather the same Lat 3.21 S
Long 116.51 W

Sunday 2nd
Commences with strong trades and pleasant
ship heading S by W ran one fin back
middle part under short sail latter fine
weather set all sail heading S by E
Lat 4.38 S
Long 117.49 W

Monday 3rd
Commences with moderate trades and pleasant
at 1 P.M. rose a shoal of sperm whales
loved the boats, streak and killed two took
look them to the ship and took in sail
latter part employed at cutting finished
at 10 A.M. Lat 4.30 S
Long 118.20 W

Commences with moderate trades and pleasant
employed at boiling middle and latter part
weather the same ran one fin back
Lat 4.36 S
Long 118.25 W

Wednesday 5th
Commences with strong trades and pleasant
employed at boiling finished at 4 P.M.
middle and latter part light trades
Lat 4.50 S
Long 118.31 W

Thursday 6th
Commences with light and pleasant
ran one fin back middle and latter part
weather the ship heading S by E
Lat 4.25 S
Long 118.04 W

Friday 7th
Coms in with strong trades and pleasant
ship heading S & E latter part heading
S & E Lat 4.00 S
Long 118.04 W

Saturday 8th
Commences with strong trades and pleasant
ship heading S by E middle and latter part
the same Lat 6.2 S
Long 118.24 W

Sunday 9th
Commences with strong trades and rugged
ship heading S by E middle and latter
part weather the same Lat 8.20 S
Long 119.12
