middle and latter part weather the same

Sunday 30th
Commences with light breezes from the
S.E. and pleasant ship heading E.S.E. middle
part heading S latter part heading E.S.E.
Lat 37.27 N

Monday 31st
Commences with light breezes from the S.E.
and pleasant ship heading E by S middle
and latter calm
