Wednesday February 2nd 1857

Commences with light breezes from the  
SSE and pleasant ship's course SSE  
middle part the same latter part strong  
breezes from the SSE  
Tatt 37.50 H  
Long 74.02 W

Thursday 3rd

Commences with fresh breezes from the  
WSE and varying ship's course SSE middle  
part strong breezes from the Westward and  
pleasant latter part varying  
Tatt 37.31 H  
Long 74.12 W

Friday 4th

Commences with light airs and calms middle  
and latter part light variable winds  
Tatt 37.20  
Long 74.40

Saturday 5th

Commences with strong breezes and squalls  
from the SW ship's course SSE middle part  
the same latter part pleasant  
Tatt 36.21  
Long 74.15

Sunday 6th

Commences with strong breezes from  
the SW ship's course SSE some many  
Porpoise took one middle and latter part  
moderate breezes from the SSE  
Tatt 35.46  
Long 75.15

Monday 7th

Commences with light airs and calms latter  
part light winds from the Eastward and passing  
rain squalls ran on finback  
Tatt 35.15 H  
Long 75.21 W

Tuesday February 8th 57

Commences with light breezes from the SSE  
Ship heading SSE ran two ships heading  
SE middle and latter part the same  
Tatt 33.46 H  
Long 74.56 W

Wednesday 9th

Commences with light breezes from the  
Eastward and pleasant ship heading SSE  
ran Porpoise & Grampises middle and  
latter part light airs and calms  
Tatt 32.52 H  
Long 74.16 W

Thursday 10th

Commences with light airs and calms at  
1 P.M. arose a school of whales leaved  
the boats streak and killed one took him  
to the ship at 7 P.M. latter part light  
winds from the Westward employed at  
cutting finished at half past eleven made  
sail and steered SE  
Tatt 32.44 H  
Long 73.56 W

Friday 11th

Commences with light winds from the  
Westward and cloudy weather employed  
at boiling steering SE under sheet sail  
middle part rained latter part light airs  
and calm employed at boiling  
Tatt 32.56 H  
Long 73.30 W
