Commences with strong breezes from the Southward ship heading S E middle part gale from the S E ship heading S W saw a ship steering S W

Commences with a gale from the S E ship heading S W middle and latter part the same

Friday 25th

Commences with fresh gale from the S E ship heading S W middle and latter part the same

Commences with fresh gals from the S E ship heading S W middle part the same latter part moderate ship heading E

Sunday February 27th 1859

Commences with strong breezes from the S E ship heading E saw several finbacks middle and latter part gale from the Southward

Monday 28th

Commences with a gale from the Southward ship heading E S E at 7 P.M. more ship heading W S W latter part heading E S E

Lat 35.22 S

Long 74.15 W

Tuesday March 1st

Commences with fresh breezes from the Southward and foggy ship heading S E by E middle part gale from the Southward latter part more moderate heading S E by E

Lat 35.40 S

Long 73.36 W

Wednesday 2nd

Commences with moderate breezes from the Southward ship heading S E by E at 4 P.M. made the land we sail in sight at 6 tack ship heading W by S latter part light winds from the North and foggy

Lat 36.10 S

Long 72.39 W

Thursday 3rd

Commences with light breezes from the S E and thick weather ship heading in for the land at 6 P.M. more ship off day light heading in at 6 P.M. made the land at 1 A.M. came to Anchor at Valchano wind from the S E
