Friday March 25th 1859

Latter part light wind and Calms to the Anchor at 6 A.M. and got under way so ends

Saturday 26th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.W. and pleasant at 2 P.M. got out the bay. Steered S by W middle part the same latter part steering S by E ran true sails

Sunday 27th

Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. and pleasant steering S by E at 6 P.M. closed S.W. middle and latter part the same

Monday 28th

Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. and pleasant ships Course N.E. W middle and latter part the same

Lat. 30.38 N

Long 78.10 W

Tuesday 29th

Commences with strong breezes from the S.W. and pleasant ships Course S.W. middle and latter part the same

Lat. 28.57 N

Long 80.22 W

Wednesday 30th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S.E. and pleasant ships Course S.W. at 4 P.M. steered S by W middle and latter part the same

Thursday March 31st 1859

Commences with light winds from the S.E. and pleasant at 5 P.M. the island St. Felix bearing N.W. dist 25 miles middle and latter part weather the same saw two ships one finback and several Blackfish

Friday April 1st

Commences with light winds and from the South and pleasant ships Course S.W. middle and latter part light airs and Calms saw two ships one finback and Blackfish

Lat. 24.42 N

Long 80.04 W

Saturday 2nd

Commences with light airs and Calms middle and latter part weather the same

Lat. 24.11 N

Long 80.16 W

Sunday 3rd

Commences with light airs and Calms saw two finbacks middle and latter part weather the same

Lat. 23.31 N

Long 81.15 W

Monday 4th

Commences with light breezes from the S.E. and pleasant ships Course S.W. middle and latter part weather the same

Lat. 22.01 N

Tuesday 5th

Commences with moderate winds and cloudy weather ships Course S by W middle and latter part the same
