heading S middle and latter part weather
the same

Thursday 21st

Commences with light breeze from the East
ships course W S W middle part the same
latter part steering W S W out the Huddon's well

Friday April 12th 1857

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading W S W middle and latter part weather
the same saw Blackfish

Saturday 13th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ships Course W S W saw many Porpoise
middle and latter part the same sent down
the fore topsail and repaired it saw
several shoals of Blackfish

Sunday 14th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ships Course W S W land the boats for
Blackfish took two middle and latter part
light airs and calm

Monday 15th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ships Course W S W saw Blackfish land the
boats took two middle and latter part weather
the

Tuesday 16th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
ships Course W S W saw two finbacks middle
part squally latter part pleasant

Commences with light trade ships Course

the same caught a Porpoise
