Sunday May 8th 1859

Commences with light trade and pleasant steering S at 6 P.M. left to the wind heading S.E. latter part steering S.W. Lat 44.14 Long by Cr 107.52 by C.D. Dist 107.12

Monday 9th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant steering S.W. at 6 P.M. left to with head yards aback saw many finbacks this day latter part steered S. saw a Bark to the Eastward Lat 44.14 Long 107.50 W

Tuesday 10th

Commences with light trade and pleasant heading S.E. saw many finbacks middle part heading S.W. latter part steering W. Lat 44.16 Long by Cr 107.55 by C.D. Dist 107.57

Wednesday 11th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant ship heading S. saw finbacks middle and latter part light trade Lat 44.30 W Long 107.37 W

Thursday 12th

Commences with light trade and pleasant saw finbacks killers grampies and Porpoise middle part weather the same latter part squally ship heading S by W Lat 45.06 S Long 107.06 W

Bark Lactia

Friday May 13th 1859

Commences with light trade and squally ship South saw finbacks Porpoise and several pieces of squid middle heading South latter part heading S.E. Lat 45.19 W Long 108.11 W

Saturday 14th

Commences with light trade and pleasant ship heading S.E. saw Blackfish lived two boats took two middle and latter part weather the same Lat by A. 45.00 S Long 108.19 W

Sunday 15th

Commences with light breezes from the Southward at 2 P.M. saw several Breaches at 4 P.M. saw the whales spouting lived the boats did not get to them before dark middle and latter part weather the same Lat 45.16 W Long 108.45 W

Monday 16th

Commences with light trade and pleasant at 1 P.M. saw a shoal of whales lived the boats and galled them got nothing middle and latter part weather the same Lat 45.16 S Long 110.14 W

Tuesday 17th

Commences with light trade and pleasant saw Porpoise middle and latter part weather the same Lat 45.17 W Long 109.58 W
