Commences with strong trade and cloudy weather ship heading E & E middle and latter part squally and rain

Tuesday 14th

Commences with strong trade and squalls of rain saw Porpoise middle and latter part weather the same at 10 A.M. raised the island of Culpeppers bearing E by S

Lat 1.37 S

Long 72.46 W

Wednesday 15th

Commences with light trade and squally ship heading S & E one sail in sight at 6 P.M. the island bearing E dist 15 miles middle and latter part pleasant

Thursday 16th

Commences with light trade and pleasant three Barks in sight chasing whals speak the Bark Glen Dory seven months out with 70 lbs middle and latter part light airs and calms saw Blackfish Caught a Porpoise

Friday 17th

Commences with light trade and pleasant five ships in sight speak the Emily middle and latter part weather the same five Barks in sight and South Sea

Lat 00.29 S

Long 72.59 W

Saturday 18th

Commences with light trade and pleasant middle and latter part the same

Lat 00.21 S

Sunday 19th

Commences with light trade saw a Bark to the windward whaling lured the Boat had no success middle and latter part weather the same two Barks in sight

Monday 20th

Commences with light trade and pleasant at 6 P.M. South Sea bearing S & E by E dist 20 miles middle and latter part weather the same five Barks in sight
