Commences with light trade and passing
rain squalls saw Porpoise ship heading N by E
middle and latter part the same Lat 12.48 N

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading N by E. Caught a bucket
middle part took a Porpoise latter cloudy
Weather Lat 13.10 N

Commences with light trade and cloudy
weather ship heading N by E saw a Steamer
heading N E middle part heading N latter
part heading N E Lat 13.00 N

Friday 5th
Commences with strong trade and cloudy
weather ship heading N E middle and latter
part heading N by E Lat 13.14 N

Long 84.61 W

Saturday 6th
Commences with strong trade and cloudy
ship heading N saw two finbacks &
many Porpoises middle and latter part
weather the same Lat 13.00 N

Sunday 7th

Commences with strong trade and cloudy
weather ship heading N saw finbacks
middle and latter part moderate rain two
Shoals of Blackfish Lat 13.02 N

fog squalls ship heading N middle part
the same latter part pleasant Lat 13.11 N

Tuesday 9th
Commences with light trade and passing
fog squalls ship heading N by E saw
Blackfish at 4 P.M. and a Shear-spine
at 5 P.M. took the lead to the ship at
Sunset and Shortened sail middle part lay
aback at daylight Commenced taking fish
at 7 P.M. mid sail heading N E

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading N E employed at boiling
saw finbacks and Porpoises middle part
the same finished boiling at 4 A.M. latter

steering N E at 6 P.M. left to the wind
middle and latter part weather the same
Lat 13.21 N

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
