employed at stowing ship heading E and
many finbacks and one school of blackfish
middle part weather the same latter part
foggy

fog reveals sun finbacks and blackfish
middle and latter part the same

Commences with strong trade and foggy

sails in sight

Friday 26th

Commences with moderate trade and
passing fog reveals sun Blackfish ship
heading N by E middle and latter part
weather the same ship heading E by S

Long 72.46 W

Saturday 27th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading E by S at 6 P.M. were ship
heading N by E latter part heading E by S

Sunday Aug 28th 1859

Commences with light trade and pleasant ship
heading E by S at 6 left to the wind heading E
middle part laying a back latter part showing
S by E

Monday 29th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
storing S by E sun two finbacks at 6 P.M.
left to heading N by E latter part storing
S by W sun a back heading to the Eastward

Tuesday 30th

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant
storing S by W at 6 P.M. left to heading N by E
latter part heading E by S

Lat 00.02 S

Long 73.14 W

Wednesday 31st

Commences with strong trade and suggest
ship heading E by S middle and latter part
in rather the same

Lat 00.34 S

Long 72.38 W

Thursday Sept 1st

Commences with strong trade and suggest
ship heading E by S middle and latter part
light trade

Friday 2nd

Commences with light trade and pleasant
at 6 P.M. South head leaving 4 E dist 25 miles
three sails in sight to the windward middle
and latter part weather the same speak
the Bark Emily
