Saturday Sept 3rd 1859
Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading E by S saw two finbacks &
a shoal of blackfish at 6 P.M. South head
leaving E by S dis 25 miles more ship heading
N.W. middle part the same latter part heading
& this ends

Sunday 4th
Commences with light trade and foggy ship
heading E saw finbacks latter part heading
N.W.
Lat 00.21 N
Long 12.02 W

Monday 5th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading N.W. saw finbacks and black
fish latter part light airs and calm
Lat 00.33 N
Long 12.13 W

Tuesday 6th
Commences with light airs and calm middle
part the same latter part light trade
ship heading E by S
Lat 00.01 N
Long 12.17 W

Wednesday 7th
Commences with light trade and fog
ship heading E by S middle and
latter part the same fine still in sight
Lat 00.14 N
Long 12.14 W

Bark Lactitia

Thursday Sept 8th 1859
Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading N.W. middle part the same
latter part heading E
Lat 00.25 N
Long 12.46 W

Friday 9th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading N.W. by W saw blackfish
latter part weather the same saw three shoals
of blackfish many birds and several pieces
of squid
Lat 00.34 N
Long 12.40 W

Saturday 10th
Commences with light trade & pleasant
ship heading E land in sight latter part
steering W
Lat 00.44 N
Long 12.50 W

Sunday 11th
Commences with light trade and pleasant
steering S.W. saw three shoals of Blackfish
middle and latter part light airs and calm
Lat 00.36 N
Long 13.05 W

Monday 12th
Commences with light trade & pleasant
steering S.E. middle and latter part weather
the same saw bark
Lat 00.33 N
Long 11.55 W

Tuesday 13th
Commences with light airs and calm caught
a turtle middle and latter part light trade
Lat 00.13 N
Long 13.04 W
