Wednesday Sept 14th 1859

Commences with light trade and pleasant
steering S.E. at 6 P.M. left to the wind
heading E middle and latter part strong trade

Thursday 15th

Commences with strong trade and thick
weather. Speak the Bark Huron thirty five
months out with 1050 spinn middle part
heading N.W. latter part heading E saw 16
blackfish & two finbacks

Friday 16th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
ship heading E middle and latter part
the same

Lat 06.17 N

Saturday 17th

Commences with moderate trade and pleas-
ant saw two sails one sailing saw Blackfish
and finbacks middle and latter part weather
the same

Lat 06.25 N

Long 11.25 W

Sunday 18th

Come in with strong trade and pleasant
ship heading N.W. saw Blackfish and two
finbacks latter part heading E

Lat 06.00 N

Long 11.14 W

Monday 19th

Commences with strong trade & pleasant ship
heading E saw Blackfish & one finback middle
and latter part foggy

Lat 06.10 N

Long 11.55 W

Bark. Sactia

Tuesday Sept 20th 59

Commences with moderate trade and thick fog
ship heading E by N middle part the same
latter part strong trade and pleasant

Lat 06.23.50 N

Long 11.10 W

Wednesday 21st

Come in with moderate trade and pleasant
middle and latter part foggy so observe

Thursday 22nd

Come in with light airs and calms at 6 P.M.
Rodender rock bearing E by N dist 20 miles
one sail in sight to the Southward
middle and latter part light trade and
thick weather

Friday 23rd

Come in with light trade and pleasant
ship heading E by N saw one shoal of
Blackfish and finback at 6 P.M. 8th
head bearing S.E. dist 50 miles middle and
latter part weather the same ship heading
N.W. saw a bark heading to the Eastward

Long 11.11 W

Saturday 24th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading E by N saw three shoals of
Blackfish and several finbacks middle and
latter part foggy
