Tuesday Oct 4th 1851

Commences with strong trade and pleasant
at 4 P.M. sent in two boats a fishing at
the Redoubt rock got a noble lot middle
part steering S.E. latter part steering E
saw a bark & schooner

Wednesday 5th

Commences with light trade and pleasant
ship heading E at 6 P.M. Alingai leaving
S.E. dist 40 miles middle and latter part
weather the same
Lat 65.18.87
Long 11.14

Thursday 6th

Commences with light trade & pleasant
ship heading E by N middle and latter part
the same saw a bark heading to the N.W.
Lat 65.16.87
Long 11.14

Friday 7th

Commences with moderate trade fog squalls
ship heading E & E saw four barks and one
sail latter part strong trade
Lat 65.46.87
Long 11.48

Saturday 8th

Commences with strong trade and rugged
ship heading E by N saw blackfish and
Porpoise middle and latter part thick weather
at 11 A.M. saw a school of whales and the
boats
Lat by N 65.30.87
Long by N 12.20.87

Sunday Oct 7th 1851

Commences with strong trade and Cloudy
thick weather boats off in pursuit of whale
streak and killed one took him to the ship
at 4 P.M. Commence cutting at 5 finished
at 7 P.M. made sail heading S.E. by E
middle and latter part heading E by N employed
at boiling

Monday 10th

Commences with strong trade and fog squalls
ship heading E & E employed at boiling
middle and latter part weather the same
finished boiling at 11 A.M.
Lat 65.25.87
Long 11.30

Tuesday 11th

Commences with strong trade and fog squalls
ship heading E & E middle part the same
latter part heading N by E
Lat 65.07.87
Long 11.31

Wednesday 12th

Commences with light trade and Cloudy
weather ship heading N by E saw a ship
heading to the Eastward middle and latter
part the same employed at skinning down
saw Blackfish
Lat 65.11.87
Long 11.50

Thursday 13th

Commences with light trade and Cloudy
ship heading E latter part heading E by N
Lat 65.10.87
Long 11.46
