Friday Oct 14th 1849

Monday 19th

Commences with light birds, then headings
H & E caught a Puffin on beach at 10
at 5 P. M. raise Point St. Helene Lighthouse
E dist 30 miles middle part having about
latter part showing E at daylight Point
Nauyas Lighthouse E dist 5 miles

Friday 19th

H. L. Pitt, Com. L. Fitch at Goules

Friday 25th

Latter part both cool and pleasant.
16 A M - took the train and got in the
city.

Sunday & 3rd

Lat. 81.55-44

Feb 4. 36

Thursday 25th

Commenced with heavy loads beating at
the east at 4 P.M. the shiping at Pacific
in weight middle and latter part beating
up to Anchorage at Payton port meridian

Sunday 30th

Latter part light, windy and pleasant at 3 A.M.
took the Anchor and got under way Sat 5.08

Aug 81.32

Monday 31st

Commence with light birds and pleasant
employed at taking up the lost middle part
strong birds better paid labor. Salt Lake.
