Commences with light trade and pleasant

latter part heading S by E

Tuesday 22nd
Commences with light trade ship heading
E by S saw five sails at 6 P.M. tack ship
heading S by W middle part the same latter
part heading S & E saw three sails

Lat 14.06 S

Wednesday 23rd
Commences with light trade and cloudy
weather ship heading E by S saw finbacks
middle and latter part strong trade and fog
saw several merchant ships
