Thursday Aug 14th 1851

Commences with strong trade and rugged ship heading & speak bark Herald of New Bedford with 6.25. spinn middle and latter part weather the same two sails

Commences with strong trade and pleasant at 4 P.M. raised the land middle and latter part light trade

Saturday 16th

Commences with light trade and pleasant saw four sails and one shoal of Blackfish this day middle and latter part the same

Sunday 17th

Commences with strong trade and pleasant saw three sails several shoals of Blackfish middle and latter part cloudy weather

Monday 18th

Commences with strong trade and cloudy weather saw three whalers and two or three ships middle and latter part weather the same

Tuesday 19th

Commences with light

Tuesday Sept 11th 1851

Commences with strong trade and rugged saw one ship middle and latter part the same at 1 P.M. saw a shoal whale lured the boat so ends

Wednesday 12th

Commences with light trade and pleasant lured off in pursuit of whale shoal for will not look them to the ship latter part strong trade employed at cutting

Thursday 13th

Commences with strong trade employed at cutting whaler and clearing away beach started the net at 5 P.M. saw three sails this day middle and latter part moderate employed at cutting

Friday Dec 2nd

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant employed at cutting saw one ship middle part lured at daylight saw a shoal of spinn whale lured the boat struck and killed one took him to the ship at 11-30 min

Commences with strong trade employed at cutting finished at 3 P.M. at 5 saw a line whale lured the boat struck and killed took him to the ship at 7 P.M. saw a ship a whaling
