Thursday Dec 15th 1857

Commences with light trade and pleasant
see whals level the boats streak fore
Walt boat capsizing and lost line parted
from one kild two took them to the ship

At 6 P.M. six boats in sight to the
Windward whaling latter part cutting
eight sails in sight three cutting

Commences with light trade and pleasant
employed at clearing away heads eight
sails in sight at 7 P.M. started the gale
middle and latter part boiling & clearing
down

Commences with light trade employed at

middle and latter part boiling

Commences with moderate trade and pleasant

five sails in sight middle and latter part
weather the same
