Commences with moderate breezes from the
ESE ship heading South middle part
the same latter part heading ESE
Lat 31.14 N
Long 88.04 W

Saturday 21st
Commences with moderate breezes from
the Eastward and pleasant ship heading
ESE middle and latter part the same
Lat 30.47 N
Long 87.11 W

Sunday 22nd
Commences with light breezes from
the SE and pleasant at 6 P.M. ran-
nials to the windward suppose they
were Spinnaker whals middle and latter
part light breezes from the Northward
Lat 31.28
Long 87.05

Monday 23rd
Commences with light airs and calms
middle and latter part light breezes from
the Westward and pleasant ship's course
ESE Lat 31.54
Long 86.14

Commences with light breezes from the
Westward and pleasant ship's course ESE
middle and latter part the same
Lat 32.40 N
Long 88.07 W

Wednesday 25th
Commences with moderate breezes from
the NW and pleasant ran fin back 8
Gannets at 6 P.M. wind shifted in a
squel to the SE middle and latter
part pleasant Lat 33.45
Long 84.23

Thursday 26th
Commences with moderate breezes from
the SE and pleasant ship heading
SE by E middle and latter part light
breezes from the SE with a large swell
from the Southward Lat 34.10
Long 83.28

Friday 27th
Commences with light winds and calms
ship heading E ran on fin back &
a school of Porpoise employed at cleaning
and painting ship in side middle
and latter part the same Lat

Saturday 28th
Commences with light breezes from the
Southward and pleasant ran a brig
steering ESE middle and latter part the
same Lat 34.46 N
Long 80.46 W
