Wednesday February 15th 1860
Commences with light winds from the Southward
and pleasant Maffaure bearing SSE dist 40
mils middle part calm latter part light
breezes from the SE saw Blackfish land
the boat took fire
Satt 32.50H
Long 81.23W

Thursday 16th
Commences with strong breezes from the
SE at 5 P.M. wind shifted to the SSE
middle part calm latter part moderate breezes
from the WSE employed at boiling snails
seven lbs
Satt 32.29H
Long 81.45

Friday 17th
Commences with strong breezes from the
WSE at 2 P.M. saw sperm whales going
SE quick land the boats had no success
at 6 P.M. wind shifted to the Southward
in a squall with rain middle and latter part
fresh breezes saw three sails steering SE
Satt 32.05H
Long 81.09W

Saturday 18th
Commences with strong breezes from the
Southward saw one ship steering SE
middle and latter part weather the same
Satt 32.04
Long 81.32

Coms in with fresh breezes from the
SE middle and latter part weather the
