Monday March 18th 1860

Commences with light winds from the
Scuttnard and cloudy weather ship heading
W S W saw a ship steering S on Bark
heading to the Eastward middle and latter
part strong breezes and squally saw a
Brig steering S E

Commences with light breezes from the S W
and pleasant ships course S E saw a Bark
steering S E middle and latter part fine
breezes ships course S E

Commences with strong breezes from the
S W and pleasant a large sea from the S W
ships course S E middle part strong at 5 A.M.
wind shifted to S S W latter part fresh breeze
ship heading S E

Commences with strong breezes from the
S S W ship heading S E by E middle and
latter part moderate

Commences with moderate breezes from the

fresh breezes from Westward ships course
S by E

middle and latter part weather the steering
