Friday March 30th 1860

Commences with fresh gale from the N.W. and thick rainy weather ship's course S. by E. at 4 P.M. shift to the wind heading S.W. middle and latter part fresh gale from the N.W.

Commences with strong breezes from the N.W. and squally bad sea on ship's head S. by E. middle and latter part strong breezes from the Northward and rainy ships

Sunday April 1st

Commences with light winds from the S.W. and rainy ship's course S. by E. a bad sea on from the S.W. Barometer down to 29 and two tenths at 6 P.M. thick weather wind hold to S.E. at 7 P.M. wind shifted to the Southward a heavy gale through night latter part moderate

Monday 2nd

Commences with light airs and calms cloudy weather at 4 P.M. light wind from the Eastward and rainy ship's course S. by E. Barometer down to 29 and two tenths middle part variable winds thick rainy latter calm and pleasant

Tuesday April 3rd 1860

Commences with a calm and pleasant at 6 P.M. light wind from S.W. and cloudy ships Course S. by E. Barometer stands 29 and 5-10 the weather looks fair for a North-Wester middle strong wind from the S.E. and rainy latter part the same

Wednesday 4th

Commences with light breezes from the S.W. and pleasant ship's course S. by E. at 6 P.M. Barometer stands 29 and 2 1/2 tenths middle part the same latter strong wind from the S.W. and rainy

Thursday 5th

Commences with strong breezes from the N.W. and thick rainy weather ship's course S. by E. at 4 P.M. shift to the S.W. and cleared off at 6 Barometer stands on 29 and 2 tenths middle part weather the same latter part strong breezes from the Southward ship heading S. by E.

Friday 6th

Commences with strong breezes from the Southward and squally ship heading S. by E. at 6 P.M. Barometer stands on 29 and 2 tenths middle and latter part squalls of snow
