Saturday April 7th 1860

Commences light winds from the Southward and squalls of snow ships heading S & E Barometer down to 29 and 4 tenths and rose up not started for three days middle part wind from the Eastward ship heading S & E latter part wind S & E with snow squalls ship heading S W

Sunday 8th

Commences with strong breezes from the S & E and squalls of snow ship heading E middle part calm latter part light winds from the S & W with snow squalls and cold

Commences with light breezes the S & W and snow squalls ship course S & E middle part light variable winds and calm latter part the same

Thursday April 12th 1860

Commences with strong breezes from the S & W and pleasant ship course S & E by E at 6 P.M. squally a bad sea from the Westward middle and latter part gale from the Westward

Commences with strong breezes from the Westward ship course S & E middle and latter part snow squalls

Saturday 14th

Commences with moderate breezes from the S & W and cloudy weather ship course S & E by E middle and latter part strong breezes and snow squalls from the Southward

Sunday 15th

Commences with strong wind and snow squalls from the S & E ship course S & E saw several Pinguins Barometer goes up three tenths to day sea stands on 29 and 4 tenths ship under close reef topsails and courses going fine not weather very cold middle and latter part the same

Commences with strong winds from the Southward and dark cloudy weather ship course S & E middle and latter part the same starting S by E saw Kelp
