rainy at 5 P. M. light wind from the N by W
and rainy ship's course S by E middle part
strong breezes latter part light winds

Commences with light breezes from the Eastward
at 5 P. M. commenced raining ship heading E
at 8 P. M. wind held to the Southward
middle and latter part strong breezes ship
course S

a heavy sea on ship's course S by E
middle part the same latter part strong
from the Westward

middle and latter part the same
