Friday April 27th 1860

Came in with strong breezes from the Westward and cloudy weather ships course S & E middle and latter part squally
Lat 33.15 N
Long 35.46 W

Saturday 28th

Commences with strong breezes from the N & W and squally ships course S & E middle and latter part light breezes and pleasant one sail in sight sun finbacks
Lat 31.15 N
Long 34.43 W

Sunday 29th

Commences with light breezes from the S & W and pleasant ships course S & E middle and latter part light variable winds
Lat 30.02 N
Long by C. D. 34.13 Long 34.13

Monday 30th

Commences with light variable winds and calms ships course S & E one ship in sight to the Westward middle and latter part strong breezes from the E & S and pleasant two sails in sight
Lat 28.44 N
Long 34.54

Tuesday May 1st

Commences with strong breezes from the E & S and squally ship heading S by W sun two finbacks middle and latter part wind from the S & E
Lat 27.40
Long 35.13

Bark Lactia Homeward Bound

Wednesday May 2nd 1860

Commences with moderate winds from the S & E and pleasant ship heading S by W middle and latter part the same
Lat 26.35 N
Long 36.35 W

Thursday 3rd

Came in with strong winds from the S & E and squally ship heading S by W sun one sail middle and latter part the same
Lat 25.45
Long 37.37

Friday 4th

Commences with strong breezes from the Northward and squally a plenty of rain sun lightning a thunder at 6 P.M. wind shifted to the N.W. stood S & E middle part variable wind and squally latter part calm
Lat 25.15
Long 36.57

Saturday 5th

Commences with light breezes from the Northward ships course S & E middle and latter part light variable winds and squally
Lat 24.32
Long 36.38

Sunday 6th

Came in with fine breezes from the S & E and squally ship heading S & E by E middle and latter part strong breezes
Lat 23.11
Long 35.55
