SE and rainy ship's course SE all
sails in sight this day middle part the
same latter part strong breezes from the
Southward nine sails in sight

Comes in with strong breezes from the South

in sight middle part variable winds from
ESE to South plenty of rain and lightning
latter part light airs and calm

Tuesday 15th
Comes in with light airs from the Northward
and rainy ship heading SSE five sails
in sight to day middle and latter part
light variable winds and pleasant
